WHAT IS THE ARKANSAS RICE REPS PROGRAM?

From April through September, Reps actively participate in a program designed to teach them about rice farming and the importance of this crop around the world through education and volunteerism.

Reps accrue volunteer hours, learn valuable leadership skills and the concepts of team building, as well as upkeep and advocacy to support important research for cultivation of rice. They are also asked to attend four different, on-site experiences during the program, to better understand the reach of rice in Arkansas.

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

During the program, Reps will not only teach and share what they have learned, but also seek other opportunities to learn and expand their knowledge.

In August, near the end of their commitment, Reps are asked to fill out the scholarship form, which makes them eligible for scholarship money.

Reps can apply for four scholarships:

- Rice Video
- Rice Recipe
- Two Volunteer/Leadership Awards

Our scholarship winners will be awarded and recognized at a final event, The Rice Reception, in September.
